At present we have 168 production and 80 skilled trades working in the plant. We had 4 people brought back to help finish off the vacation time at the end of year. The company kept 1 of them to work on the north line, and the other 3 were surpluses. There also was a reduction of 10 skill trades in the plant. The Ford side is working 5 Days a week, 1 and a half shifts a day. In the expansion, the G.M side, they are working 20 out of 21 shifts. G.M. is taking every block we can make.

The north line in the core room is still down. They are in the process of programming the robots on that line. The target Date to start up is Jan 28//08. When they are ready it will be back up to running 3 shifts. The unfortunate part is, it will not require as many people to run, on the 3 shifts. We have 35 people working in the core room at present. When they give me the numbers for the North line, I'll let you know. I am still bargain with management on that issue.

The in plant committee would like to thank everyone at W.,A.P. for their support, hourly/salary, for making the Friends of Richard Nemeth Food & Toy drive another great success this year. We helped 20 needy family's in the west end community.
