At W.A.P. manpower is at 261, production is at 190 and trades 71. The numbers went up for the Ford 3.0 litre from 4000 to 6500-7000 so currently they are running 3 shifts on the north line, has been 6 Days a week and the last 4 weeks they started up the south line also running a partial shift on Days which brought back 10 people. Also the had to req. in the 6 union awareness people for production 4 went to finish to run 2 full shifts and 2 went to T.S.R. for extra Vac/Spa replacements. The south Line was only supposed to run until shutdown. The company informed me that it will run 2 weeks after shutdown and reevaluate after that.

The Union awareness is 46% done and that will start back up the week of July 28/08 which will not increase the manpower because in T.S.R Dept. they are re-doing the C-5 conveyer, so they can blast the 3.6 litre and 3.0 Litre on the east and west shot blast which will shutdown the north and eliminate 6 jobs in that area, they will use them for training.
