We are not running any production the 3 days prior to the Christmas break. They are scheduling clean up and maintenance for these days.

The GM side is now scheduled to run through the end of January. We are running 5 days, and 2 shifts. We have approx. 6700 blocks in inventory. This is starting to get a little frustrating that Monterrey is not committing to run for a longer period of time. At the same time I am glad for every week that we are running, since this was only to be an 8 week run when we started in August.
