### ANNEX

The following letter has been written to inform the Annex and its support departments of the upcoming reductions that will take place due to the loss of shift at WEP effective November 1, 2010.

The following numbers are not final but are the actual numbers that the company has provided the Union when they first met with us on Thursday, August 12, 2010.

We are providing the reduction numbers at this time to give all members a realistic view of each department post November 1, 2010. This should help put to bed the rumors that have been circulating and give all members a chance to bid and control their own destiny.

#### HEAD MACHINING 8651 & 8653

The Head Machining department has recently seen some Coyote jobs get posted on Friday August 13, 2010. These Production jobs were posted as a result of the company needing to add the second and third shifts in Coyote Head Machining Mod "A". They will be running a build ahead for EEP. These jobs will clear and the successful applicants will train replacements on their existing jobs prior to moving into Mod "A" Coyote. Once they arrive in Mod "A" they then receive training on their new job.

After hearing from the company regarding the forthcoming reductions we addressed the issue of getting the people that are already in the Coyote program and who will be reduced their bidding rights returned. The company responded stating "NO" they will not give the locked in people their bidding rights back. Therefore all people who had bid to the Coyote program under the lock in period and do not have the seniority to retain a job in the department will be locked in until they are reduced.

Please remember when bidding on a Coyote job, if you will not have the seniority to remain in the department post Nov 1, 2010 you will be locked in until that time and unable to bid company wide to control your own destiny.
