Essex Engine will be posting the final engine line 8383 jobs at the end of the January. The line will have approximately 125 people with 10 to 15 off standard jobs. The off standard jobs will be reviewed and posted going forward while some will disappear as equipment gains capability and verification is not required.

The Crank dept. 8384 will post 4 jobs for a temp midnight shift. The jobs will be posted shifts 1, 2 & 3, 1 at present. This midnight shift will go until May when we post the 2nd production shift on afternoons.

The stock dept 8321 will post 4 drivers jobs to fill out shift requirements for the drivers group.

The Building services dept 8340 will post 1 job due to plant requirements.

All people interested in these postings should and must attend an information meeting to fully understand all job requirements.

I would like to thank and recognize the generosity of the membership in these tough times during the united way campaign and thanks to some very special people here at EEP who took the time to canvass the plant so we could all make Christmas easier for some families who had lost all to house fire during the holidays.
